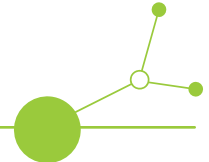


SITE VISIT IN MUNICIPALITY OF GROSUPLJE



A site visit to municipality of Grosuplje was paid in August 2024.

The purpose of a site visit paid to Grosuplje was to collect all relevant on-field information for planning and implementation of a pilot deployment of a DRT service between July and October 2025. DRT will operate on the route between Grosuplje main bus station and settlement of Polica.

The municipality of Grosuplje is a medium-sized Slovenian municipality located on the south-eastern edge of the Slovenian capital of Ljubljana. It is 134 km² in size and has 18,808 inhabitants. It is known above all for its rich cultural and historical heritage and as a developed craft and industrial city, which is only a good twenty-minute drive by car from Ljubljana on the highway in the direction of Zagreb (Croatia).

Today, Grosuplje is an administrative, economic and traffic centre, comprising several settlements, among them Polica settlement in NE of the municipality.

PT in Grosuplje mainly connects relatively small settlements around the centre, to the main transport hub in the centre, where the main bus and railway stations are located

Main points of interest in Grosuplje Municipality: railway and bus station, parking garage, municipality headquarter, administrative unit, two elementary schools (“Luis Adamič” and “Brinje”), health centre, city market, shopping centres, home for retirees, football stadium, etc.





Besides the line PPT also two DRT complimentary transport services are available in Grosuplje:

- The “Grosupeljčan” service offers a free DRT between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. within the municipality of Grosuplje and beyond (Ljubljana, Novo Mesto).
- The “Zapeljivec” service is a special designed electric car for personal transport in city centre, in particular in pedestrian areas.
