Many smaller cities face challenges such as **limited budgets**, **fragmented data**, **and insufficient planning capacity**. The OPTI-UP Strategy responds to these needs by providing a **step-by-step workflow**, from analysing the current situation to defining actions, testing scenarios with transport models, and establishing a robust monitoring framework with KPIs.

Developed collaboratively with **six pilot cities**, the methodology is rooted in real-world experience and shaped through consultations, study visits, internal surveys, and iterative feedback. It includes tools and templates for SWOT analysis, best-practice assessment, goal setting, action definition, modelling, and evaluation making it a highly practical resource for cities at different levels of readiness.

## Key features of the strategy include:

- A practical, modular planning methodology
- Tools for integrating public transport with spatial planning
- Guidance on four-step modelling and LUTI modelling
- Templates for KPIs, action plans, surveys, and best-practice documentation
- Alignment with EU mobility objectives and national policy frameworks
- Stakeholder engagement methods that build ownership and improve decisionmaking
